Going from complementarities to synergies:


- Agreement on "pilot chain of projects" per flagships
- Agreement on a road map






II ACTION LAB: NOW, WHAT?...WHAT ACTIONS CAN SUPPORT COMPLEMENTARITIES?

- Each flagship is not a pre-defined but an ongoing and collaborative process, that will be filled in with contents by the stakeholders: MAs and project's beneficiaries.
- Flagships are multi-programmes and multi-projects
- Towards Chains of projects:
 - Identify topics;
 - Build a multi-programme framework;
 - Collaboration has to be ensured during the preparation of the calls; the implementation process, between programmes but also between projects (ongoing capitalisation);
 - Capitalisation of results.


II ACTION LAB: NOW, WHAT?...WHAT ACTIONS CAN SUPPORT COMPLEMENTARITIES?

From the call to the selection of the operations	Chain of projects: parallel/coordinated calls	Joint Call for proposals (example, ERA-NET)
Identification of the objectives/contents of the calls	Harmonised approach between programmes	Jointly defined and common to all the funding organisations
Text of the call for proposal/ToR	Different calls for proposals	One single text. The call is announced also by relevant funding organisations
Funding rules and eligibility criteria	Different funding rules and eligibility criteria	Different funding rules and eligibility criteria of the relevant funding organisation
Evaluation criteria	Different for each programme. Possibility to set up harmonised selection criteria to assess the contribution to the flagship (i.e bonus, extra points)	Common evaluation criteria
Selection process	Carried out by each programmes	Both centralised (joint committee) and decentralised to the single funding organisation
Final decision on funding	Taken by each programme	Taken by each funding organisation
Timing	Possibility to harmonise calendars of the calls	Single calendar
